If either District 87 or Unit 5 are closed due to weather or an e-learning day, WBB will also be closed. No refunds or make-ups can be given for closings due to bad weather or e-learning.

WBB closings will be announced on the Remind App and our Facebook page.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Back to School Picnic: This is an annual event! We look forward to celebrating the beginning of the school year with all our WBB families!

BEHAVIOR

Please note that it is our primary intention to help children learn appropriate social behaviors and learn from the re-direction techniques we employ. The staff will encourage acceptable behavior and help the children understand what is expected of them. The intent is to help each child find acceptable ways to interact with other children. While we attempt to accommodate the needs of all children attending our program, we recognize that we cannot always meet the specific needs of every child. When such a circumstance occurs, the classroom teachers and the director will communicate with the child's family to help identify an appropriate educational environment that will address the child's needs. Please review the behavior consequence plan, and direct any questions to your child's teacher or the director.

SNACKS/WATER BOTTLES

With the prevalence of allergies and other health concerns, the program will provide snacks each day in order to keep all children who attend Wesley United Methodist Church and Wesley's Bright Beginnings safe.

Your child will need a filled spill proof/covered water bottle each day they come to preschool.

BIRTHDAYS

We will have a supply of special treats to recognize birthdays. If you would like to make the day even more special, you may send plates and/or napkins with your child's favorite character, color, or theme.

SAFETY AND COURTESY

Parking Lot: Do not leave children unattended in your car at any time. Also, please keep little ones within arm's reach while navigating our busy parking lot. Additional parking is located approximately half a block west of the church at 409 E. Front Street.

Entrance: The church doors are locked to ensure the safety and security of the facility. We are planning to have a greeter at the door at both drop-off and pick-up times. If there is not someone to greet you, please ring the doorbell and inform the staff that you are with WBB so you can be let in. We kindly ask that any items such as car seats be left in the nook by the elevator and the back stairs. Thank you!

Inside: As a courtesy to church staff and members and for your own child's safety, please use walking feet and indoor voices inside the building.

Wheelchair Ramp: Please do not allow children to run or climb on the ramp inside the building or the ramp outside the parking lot entrance.

Elevator: If you are able, please get into the habit of using the stairs, which minimizes conflict among the kids, and frees the elevator for those with strollers, carriers or physical limitations. It also helps little ones practice doing stairs safely. If you do use the elevator, please make sure little ones Do Not push the HELP button. Although you don't hear a sound, it does ring the security company who then has to contact the church unnecessarily. If this does accidentally happen, please notify the front office.

CLOTHING

Please dress your children in clothing suitable for play.

All children should have an extra set of season appropriate clothing (including socks) and 2 diapers or undergarments in their backpack.

It is helpful if a child can manage his/her own snaps and buttons. (Elastic waists are great for preschool!)

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

Because it is our goal to create a safe environment for all of our children, we ask that parents/guardians participate in the following procedures.

Upon arrival

- Each child should be escorted to their classroom by a parent, guardian, or responsible adult.
- Help your child wash his/her hands with a wipe, hand sanitizer, or soap and water.
- Sign your child in each day.

Upon dismissal

- Sign your child out each day.
- Your child will be allowed to leave only with persons listed on the Dismissal Authorization Form that you completed. It is important that a child knows who will pick him or her up each day. If your plans change, please notify the teacher via the Remind App or text message. If you will not be able to be reached at home or work, please leave a number where you can be reached by your child's teacher.

Activities start at 9 a.m. Teachers arrive earlier to prepare for the day. Children may not be left earlier than 9 a.m. and need to be picked up promptly at 11:30 a.m.. Teachers have many fun and interesting activities planned- if your child is late, it is harder to get settled into the group, and some activities may be missed.

LATE PICK-UP POLICY

A late fee of \$1 per minute may be assessed for children who are picked up later than 11:35. This is planning time for the teachers and must be respected. We appreciate that things beyond your control may cause you to be late on a few occasions. It is most helpful if you call the program to inform us you may be late. In the case of chronic late pick-up, a child may be removed from the program.

PHILOSOPHY

It is our philosophy at Wesley's Bright Beginnings to create a learning experience where children are encouraged to explore their world in an exciting, friendly environment.

Play is an important part of your child's life. It aids in social and physical development, builds his/her mind, helps in learning to make decisions, and forms good habits. The materials, toys and experiences we provide will help him/her to learn and live creatively.

At WBB we provide a multicultural learning experience where children learn about the diversity of the world around them through the stories we read, songs and poems they learn, the games they play, and the art projects in which they are involved.

We believe that every child is a unique individual with special talents and needs. Parents can feel secure in knowing that their child is respected and well-cared for while attending WBB.

WHO MAY ATTEND

A child must be the class age by September 1.
(Example: A child should turn 4 by Sept. 1 to be eligible for 4s class.)

Toddlers- 12 months

Twos- must be 2 by September 1

Threes- must be 3 by September 1 and potty trained

Fours- must be 4 by September 1 and potty trained

***Classes require
adequate enrollment and staff to remain open.***

REGISTRATION

Registration for the 2026-2027 school year will be open to families currently enrolled in WBB and Wesley Church members on Wednesday, January 14th, 2026. Applications will be sent home with current families and made available to Wesley Church members the week prior to this date. Class lists will be started with this group of applications. After this date, all applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration will **open to the public on Tuesday, January 27th, 2026.**

A non-refundable fee of \$110 per family is due upon registration.

A child should be enrolled in the class of the age that he/she will be as of September 1st, 2026. Classes will be available only if adequate enrollment is received.

If you have questions concerning registration, contact the Director.

HEALTH

Please notify the teacher via the Remind App or text message before class begins if your child will be absent for any reason. If your child has a contagious disease, please let us know so that we can notify others of the possible exposure to their children. You may call the church office at 827-8046 ext. 1021 to leave a message.

If a child becomes ill while at Wesley's Bright Beginnings, every effort will be made to notify the parents immediately to pick up their child. Children with the following symptoms/illnesses are asked to stay home from WBB:

- Unexplained rash or fever over 100 degrees (oral)
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting (24 hours)
- Conjunctivitis (until 24 hours after treatment has been initiated)
- Strep Throat (until 24 hours after treatment has been initiated)
- Head Lice (until morning after the first treatment)
- Chicken Pox (until at least six days after onset of rash)
- Respiratory virus symptoms that aren't explained by another cause including fever, chills, fatigue, cough, runny nose and headache among others.

**Children may return to school when symptoms are improved overall
AND have been fever free for a minimum of 24 hours
WITHOUT using fever-reducing medication.**

FEES

The annual cost of tuition is made in 9 monthly payments. Payments are due by the 5th of the month, starting in September.

Credit Card Payments Available Online ONLY

For credit card payments, go to www.wesley-umc.com On the navigation bar to the far right click “give”, then “online giving”. Create an online profile. Choose WBB Tuition under the Wesley’s Bright Beginnings heading, enter your tuition amount plus a **\$5 processing fee (per transaction)** and your child’s name. For questions regarding tuition, please contact Julie Loy.

A late fee of \$15.00 will be added for payments received after the 5th of the month. If payment plus late fee is not received by the end of the month in which it is due, then the child may be removed from the program. If your check is returned for any reason, there will be a \$10 returned check fee.

Tuition is based on an annual rate, and for your convenience, it is divided into 9 equal payments.

Extended Leave Policy: If you choose to leave for an extended period, you are still responsible for the month(s) your child is not in attendance.

Unenrollment Policy: If you choose not to complete the year after 2/1/2026, you are responsible for completing tuition payments through May.

Unenrollment for any reason prior to 2/1/2026 will result in a cancellation fee of one month’s tuition. Tuition will not be pro-rated for an reason including vacation, sick days, snow days, or when unit 5 / district 87 is closed for e-learning.

Additional children from the same immediate family who are enrolled at the same time will receive a \$5.00 per month discount. The first child will pay full tuition, and each child registered thereafter will be eligible for the discount.

Make checks payable to: Wesley’s Bright Beginnings and note monthly tuition on the memo line. If the child’s last name is different from the person writing the check, please write the child’s full name on the memo line.

No refunds or make-ups are given for absences or cancellations due to bad weather, or when unit 5 / district 87 have an e-learning day.

SCHEDULE

Wesley’s Bright Beginnings is open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings from 9- 11:30 a.m.

While at WBB children participate in free play, circle time, learning centers, music and art, as well as games, fingerplays, snack and one-on-one experiences with teachers. All classes are structured by the teacher with age appropriate activities and schedules which keep the individual child’s needs in mind. Therefore, classroom games, books and activities are coordinated to teach the child valuable lessons about themselves and the world around them.
